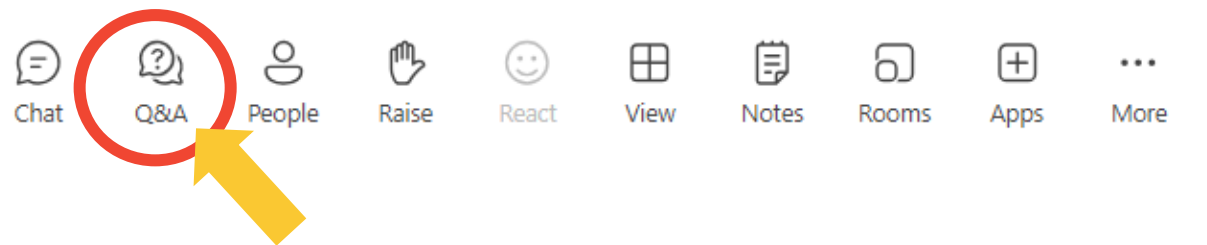

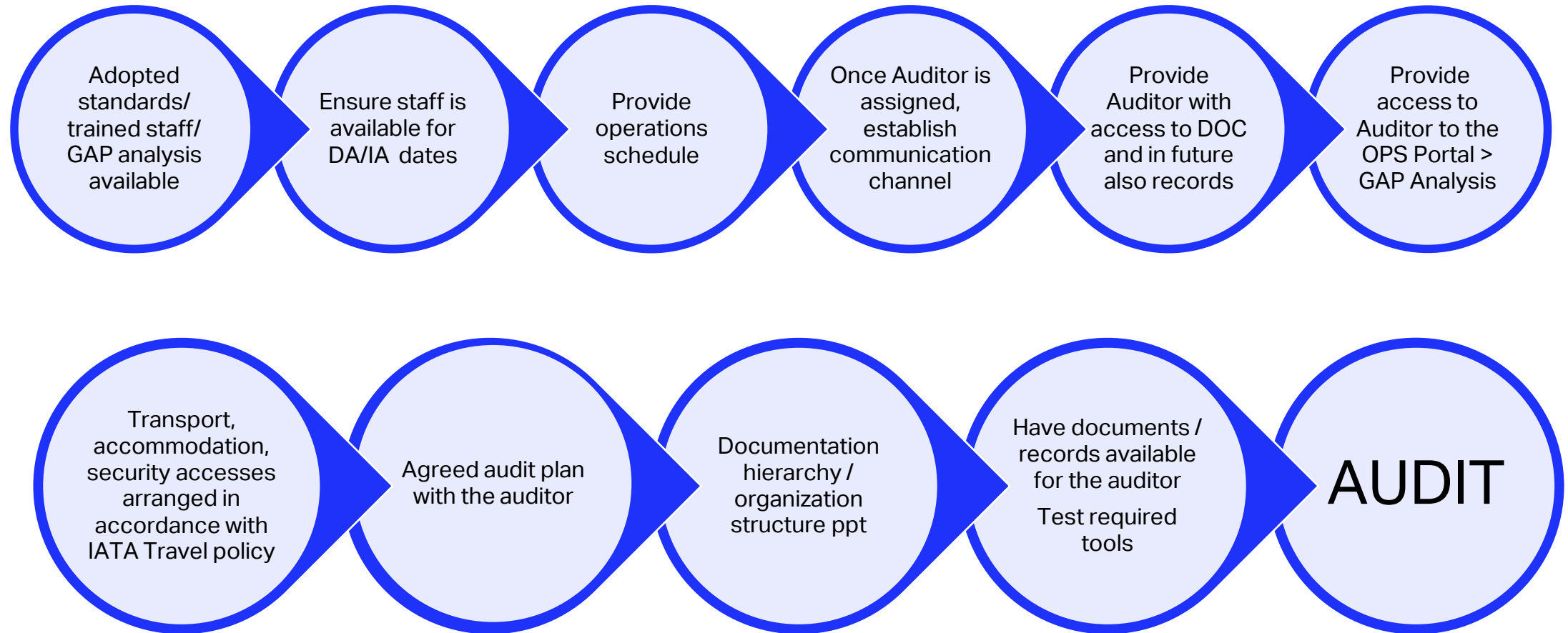

OPS Portal considered a useful tool



GHSP needs to prepare thoroughly with accurate documentation references



GHSP needs to ensure continued up to date GAP analysis

Q4 2024 Pilot audits feedback for GHSPs

Accuracy of the **GAP analysis** document references

Applicable document references to each type of audit (MHQ or STN) (pay attention to cloning and adjust to local conditions). MHQ does not have the same scope as it does currently

Do the **correct adoption mapping** (adoption assessment)

Be mindful that it is not about copy-pasting manuals but ensuring that **procedure/process need to operationally make sense** to the location and be applicable to the audited operations.

Mindful during the audit preparation (Standards adoption) and QC your GAP to avoid additional interviews/resources/ time.

Q4 2024 Pilot audits feedback for GHSPs

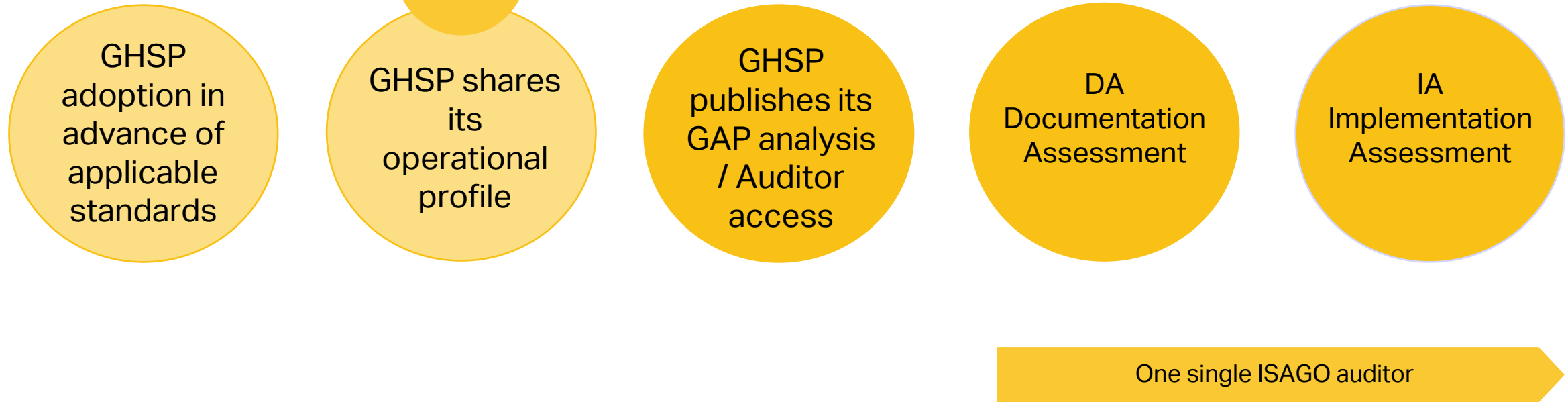
- Be mindful that a **thorough gap analysis will be available for other stations** to clone and reuse and adapt to their local conditions.
- Be aware that **each Station needs to review the cloned GAP analysis** and adapt it to the local operations and variations
- Provide timely **documentation access to the auditor**
- Understand the variations policy.
- Be skilled in preparing and presenting records/evidence.

Audit flow & timelines



High level audit flow

Temporarily a MS form (initial audits), in the future through IATA Connect, by mid-JUN will be incorporated into IATA Connect

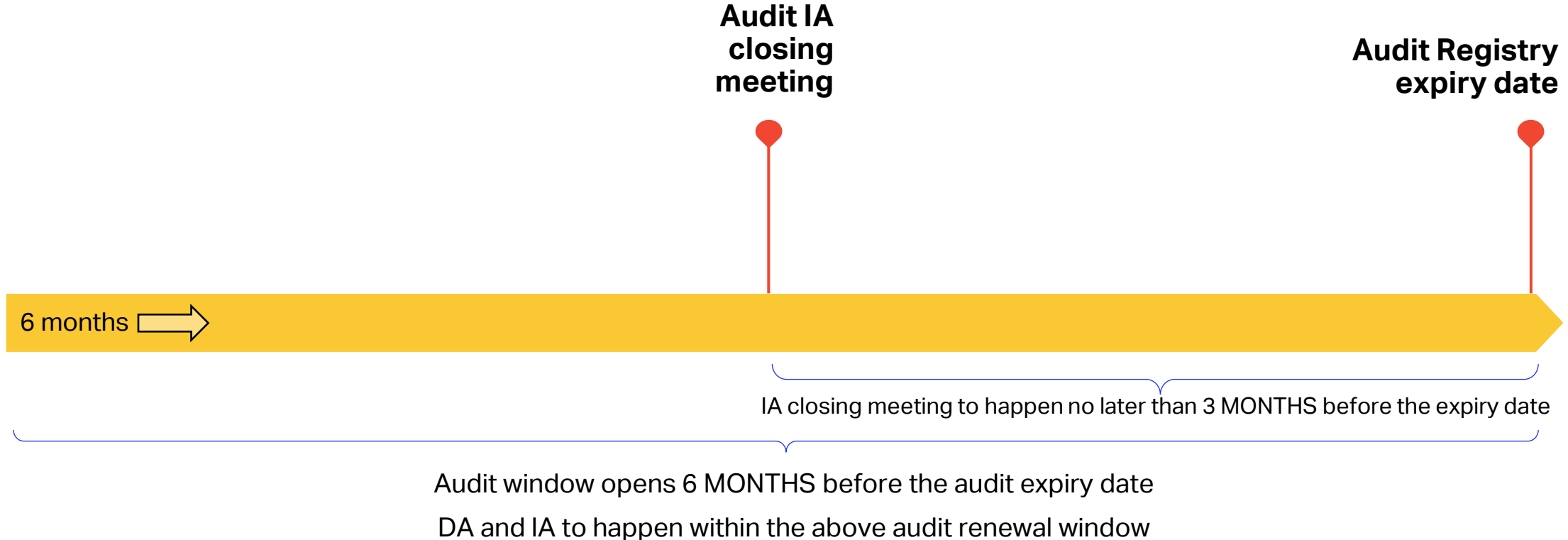


NOTE: to ensure audits happening in 2025 are performed according current AHM/IGOM and not the effective ones from JAN26, please **ensure that at least a drafted and QC'd gap analysis against current AHM/IGOM is available in the OPS Portal before the end of JUN25**



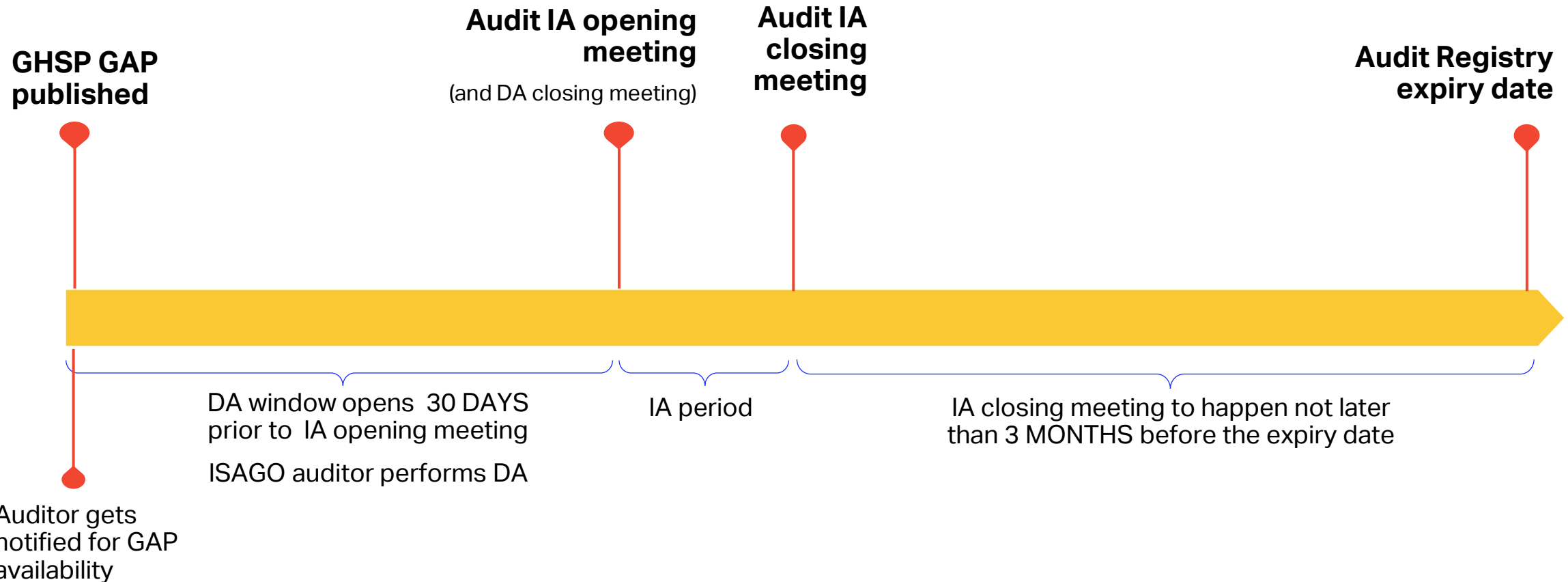
Timeline – STN or MHQ renewal audit

- Once audit agreement has been signed, the ISAGO audit implementation assessment (IA) closing meeting date will be established
- Pre-established audit date taking as a reference the current registration/accreditation expiry date
- GOA is allocated with the audit and contacts GHSP and agrees on the audit date

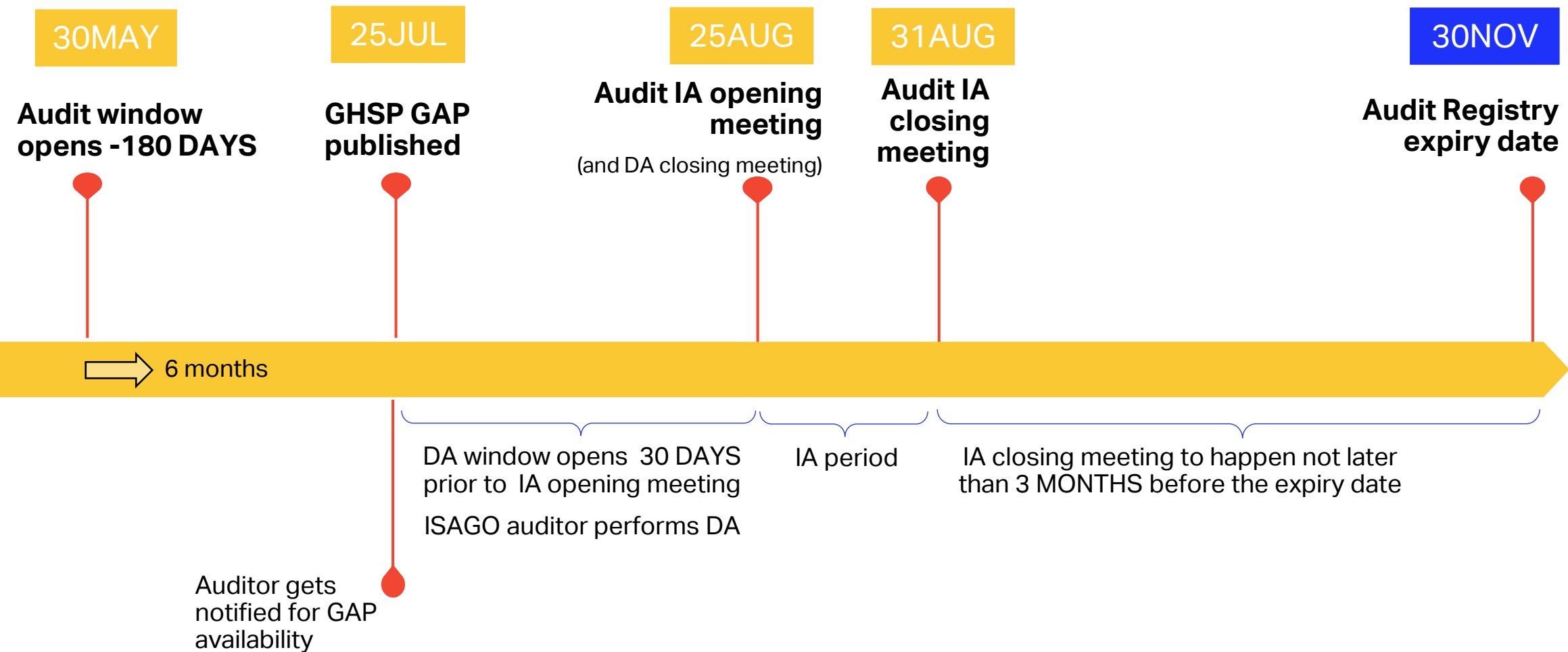


Timeline – STN or MHQ renewal audit

- Once audit implementation assessment (IA) closing meeting date has been established
- IA opening meeting is established
- Documentation Assessment (DA) period opens 30 days prior to IA opening meeting



Timeline scenario – STN or MHQ renewal audit



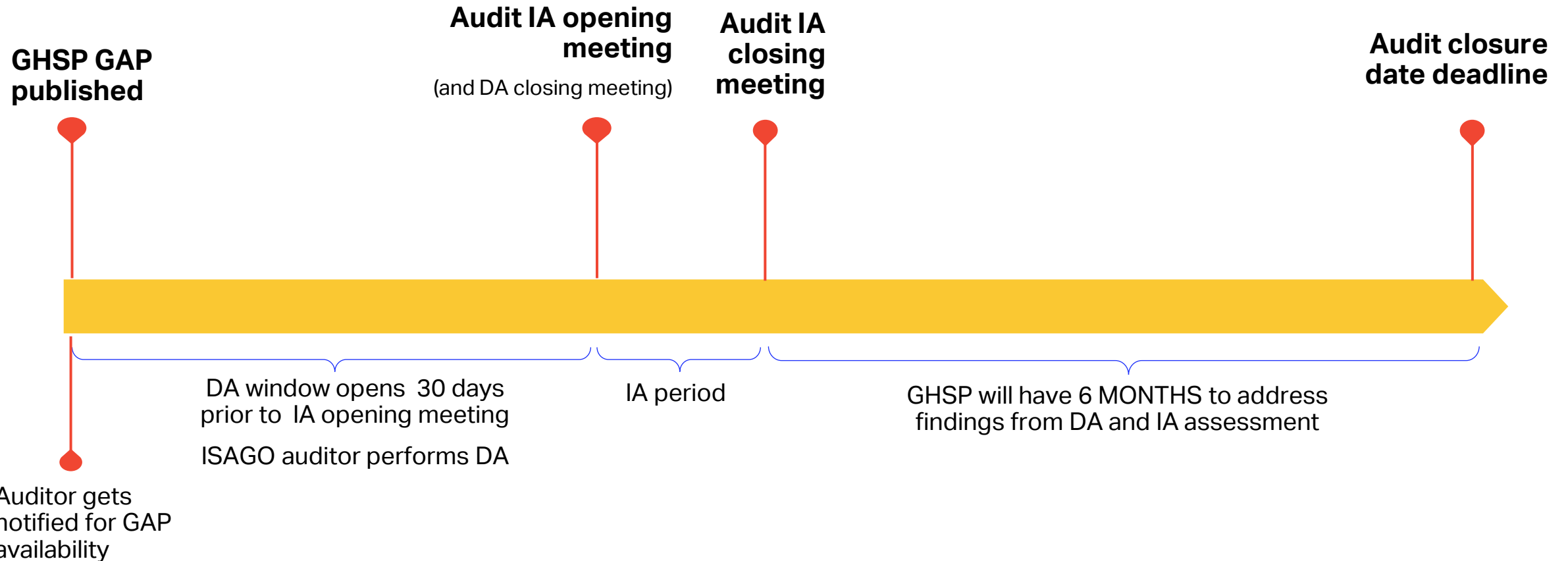
Timeline – STN initial audit

- Once audit agreement has been signed, the IA closing meeting date will be established
- GOA is allocated with the audit and contacts GHSP and proposes dates for an initial audit
- The date for initial audit will be driven by and coordinated with IATA



Timeline – STN initial audit

- Once the audit date/IA is agreed, this will define the timeline for DA
- Documentation Assessment (DA) period opens 30 days prior to IA opening meeting
- GHSP will have 6 months to address DA and IA findings



Audit documentation assessment

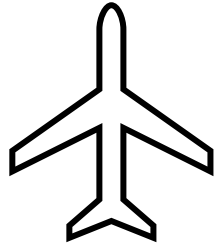
MHQ Renewal / STN Initial & Renewal audits



- Auditor performs DA on her/his own and no interview meant to happen
- Auditor will require clarifications to the GHSP on documentation references, only if needed
- No corrections allowed during the DA
- If any documentation issue, only one documentation finding
- Additionally, for MHQ renewals the GHSP to be ready for implementation records review

Audit implementation assessment

STN Initial & Renewal audits



- Flight / operations schedule to be available to the auditor as soon as possible but not later than 7 days prior IA opening meeting
- Auditor plans all assessment activities around selected operations (not interview centric)
- Auditor observes all applicable standard provisions to the GHSP (no sampling)
- In general, no implementation interviews for ops. disciplines, unless specific operations could not be observed (records, oversight, etc.)
- If any implementation, multiple findings implementation finding

Timeline – MHQ initial audit

Once audit agreement has been signed, the ISAGO audit closure deadline will be established

– Initial MHQ audit date assigned:

- Depending on readiness of the GHSP (gap published/GHSP profile completed), and
- GHSP to provide evidence that a monitoring activity (e.g. QC has been performed on the published GAP analysis)
- Although the GHSP might have a preference for DA/IA start date, specific periods provided by IATA for the GHSP to select the most convenient start date or DA&IA date

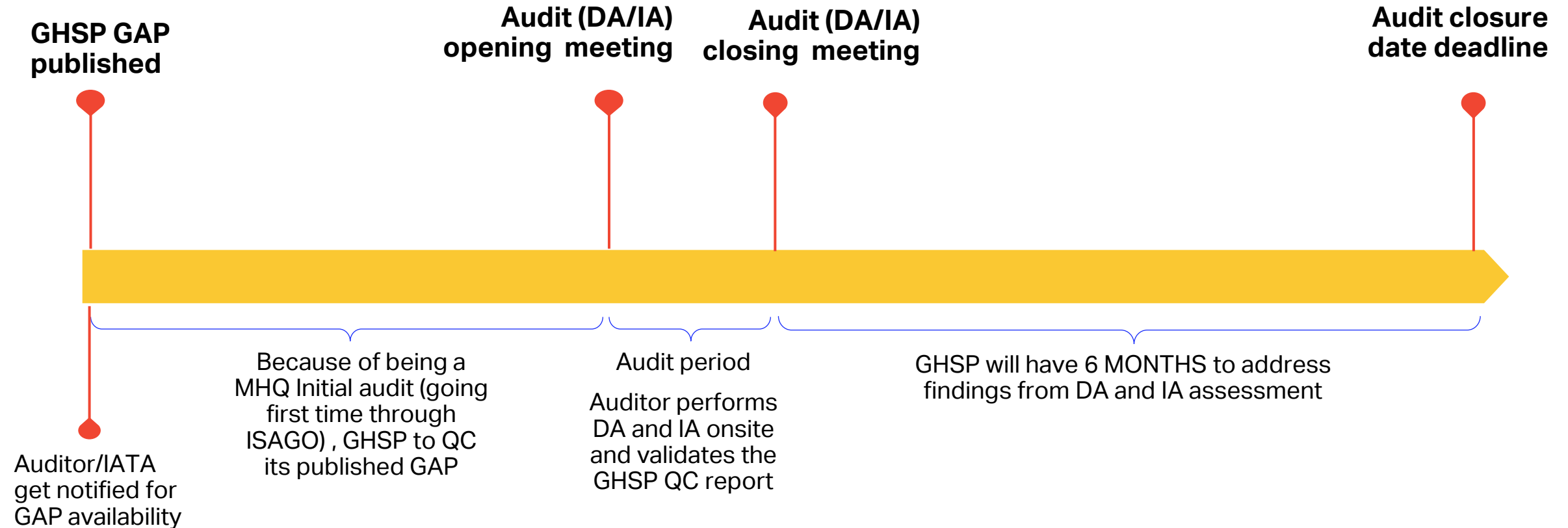
Timeline – MHQ initial audit

- Once audit agreement has been signed, the audit closing meeting date will be established
- GOA is allocated with the audit and contacts GHSP and proposes dates for an initial audit
- The date for initial audit will be driven by and coordinated with IATA



Timeline – MHQ initial audit

- Once the audit date is agreed, this will define the timeline for the publication of the GAP
- GHSP to publish GAP analysis publication at least 30 days prior to audit opening meeting
- GHSP will need to QC the published GAP
- GHSP will have 6 months to address audit findings



Audit documentation assessment

MHQ Initial

- Same methodology as per the other type of audits (sampling) but onsite
- Additionally, GAP needs to be QCd by the GHSP and have record evidence
- Although the DA happens onsite , it is not meant to have “audit interviews” but instead support to the auditor if requires clarifications on GHSP documentation references
- No corrections allowed during the DA
- Only one documentation finding



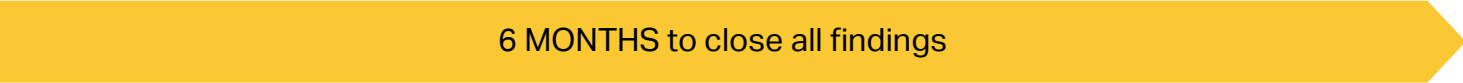

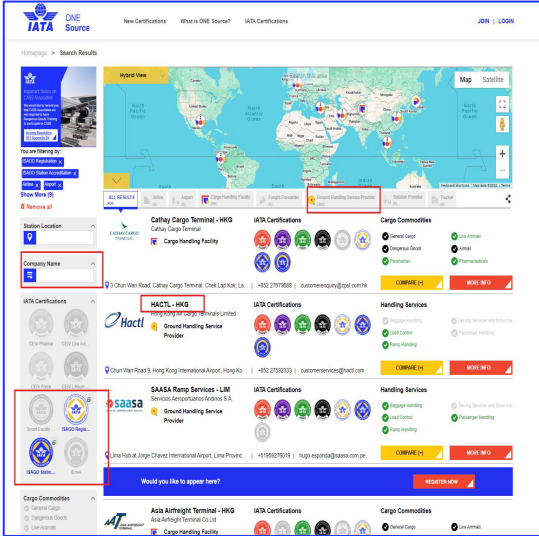

Audit process simplification: single auditor, CARs management, no DA interviews, focus on implementation

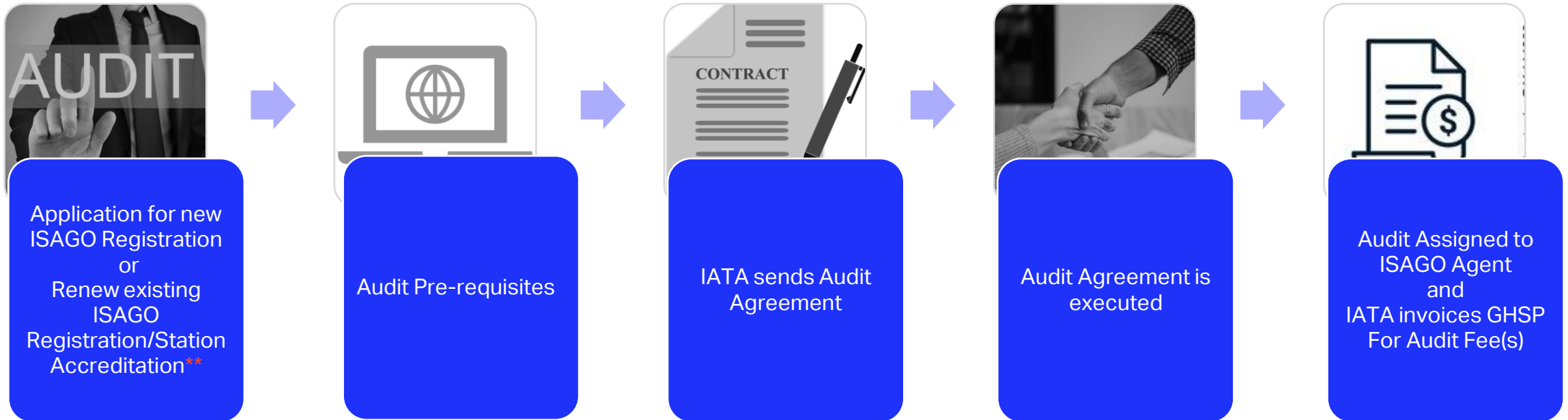
No CTN audit

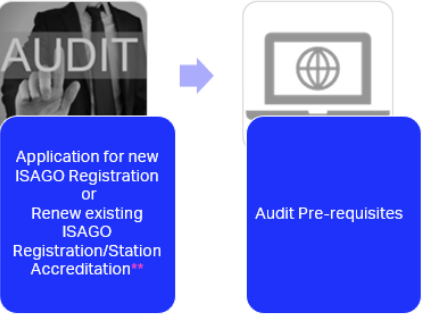
Audit Application Overview

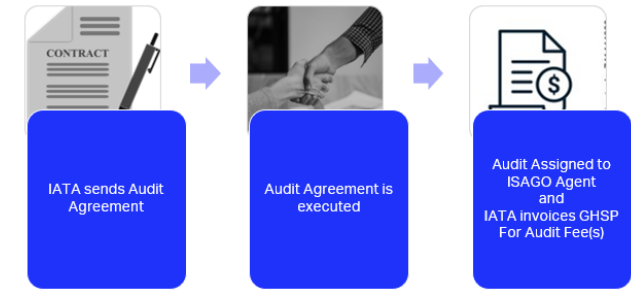
First 2 steps, communicated via GHSP Bulletins:

GHSP profile form will be shared with the agreement or with the initial audit email

From mid-2025 through a new tool (IATA Connect)

GHSP drafts its GAP analysis to familiarize with the standards, the tool and prepare its readiness for the audit.

Modular Format

- Contract Front Sheet
- Part A – the general supply terms – this portion of the Agreement contains the generic contractual terms and provision that apply to all products and services within IATA
- Part B – product and services terms applicable to ISAGO
- Schedule A (known today as Schedule C)

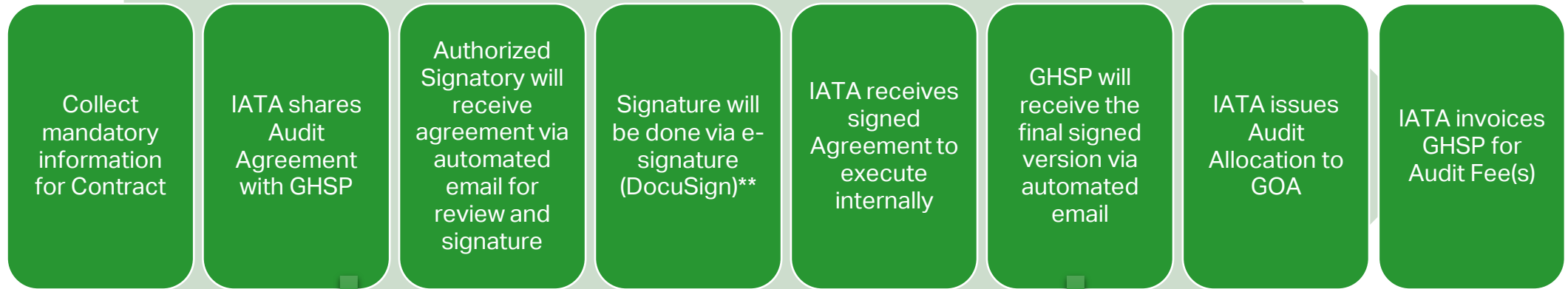

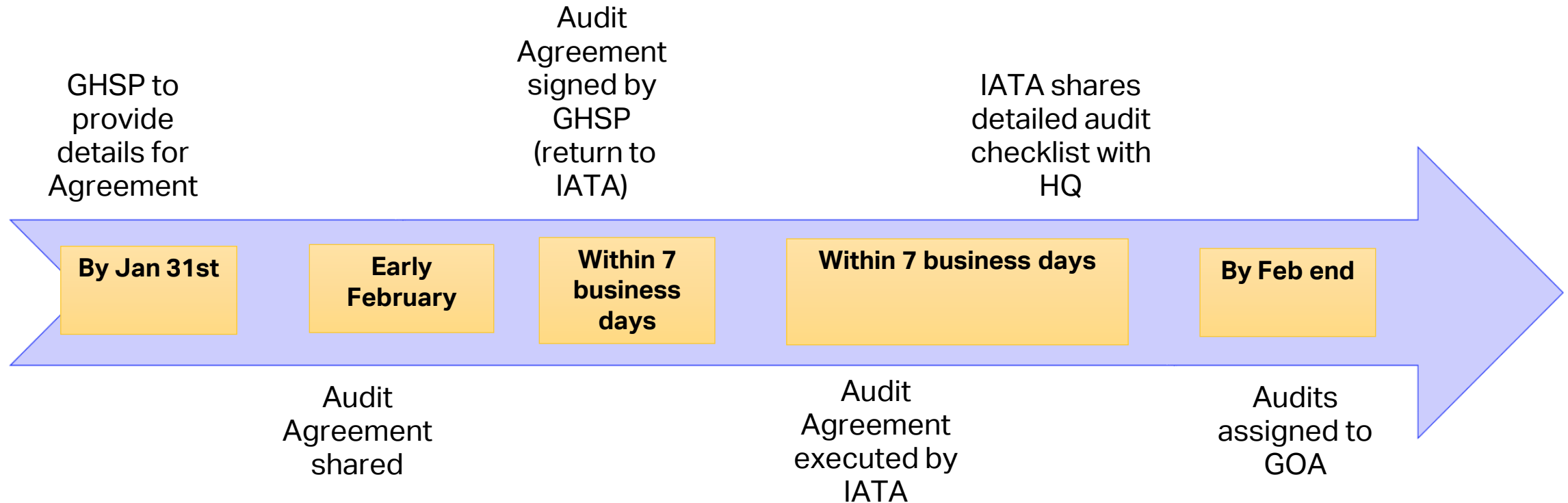

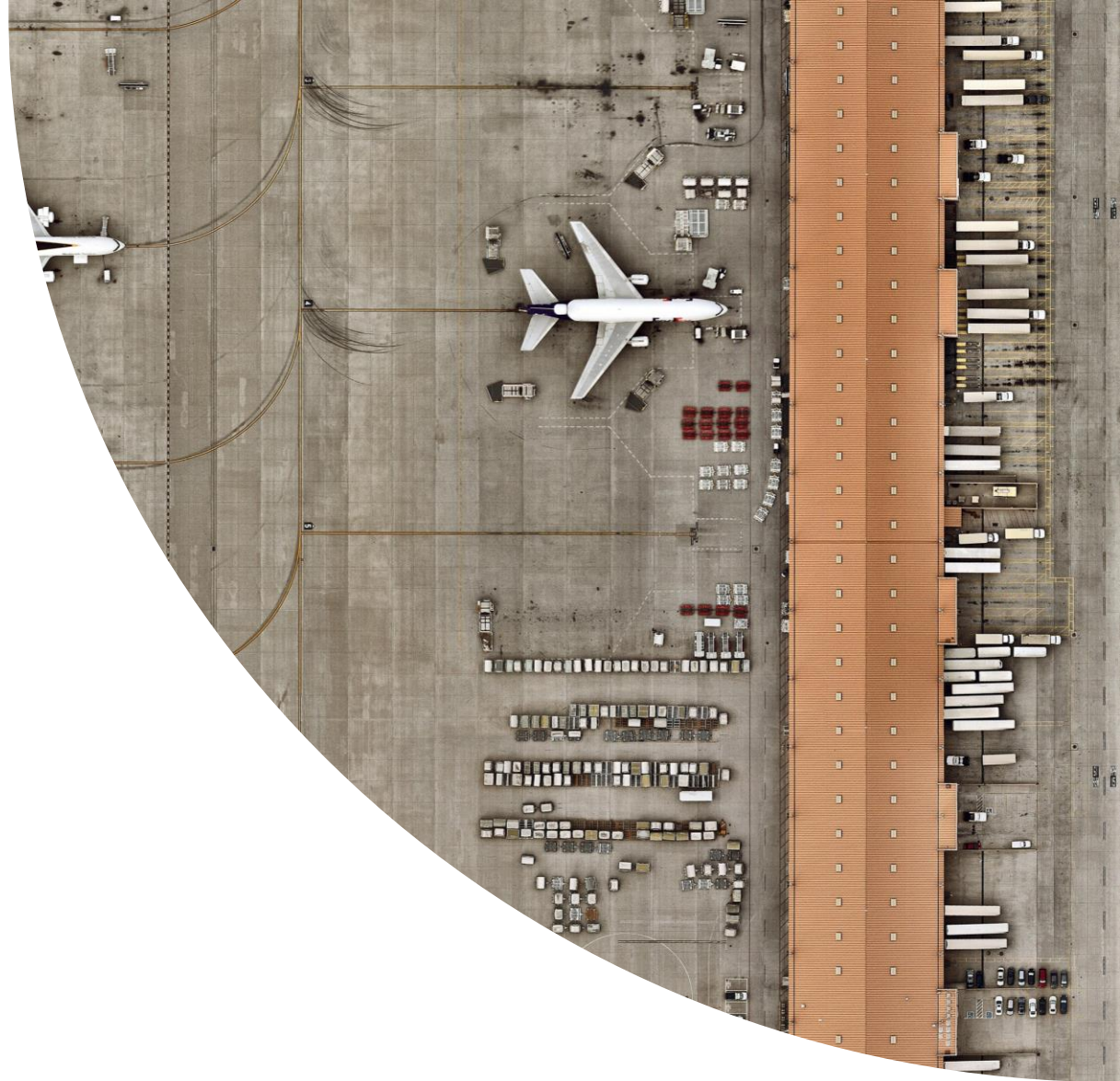

- IGOM/AHM knowledge test to verify understanding

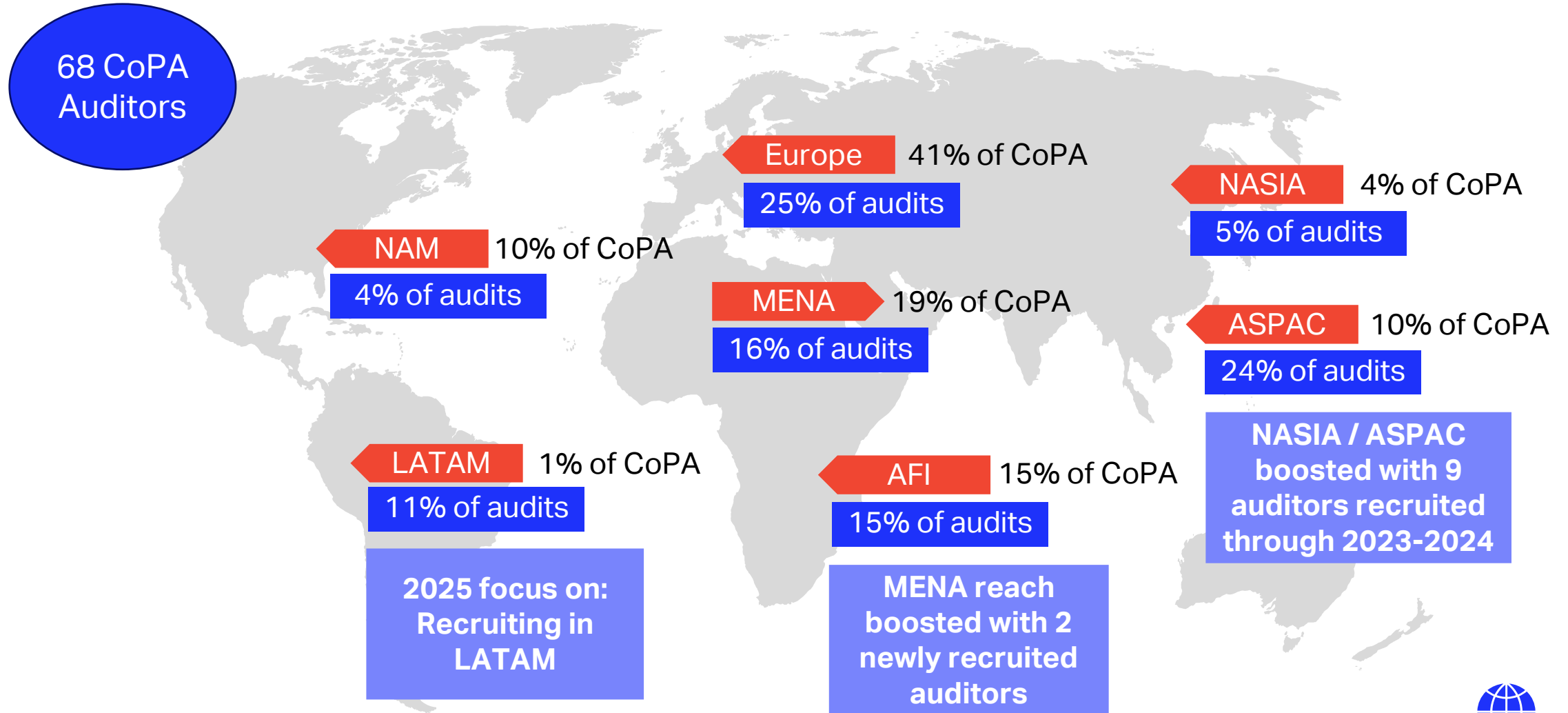
Culminating on a 3-day F2F training with [hands on exercises](#) on New Audit Methodology.

Additionally:

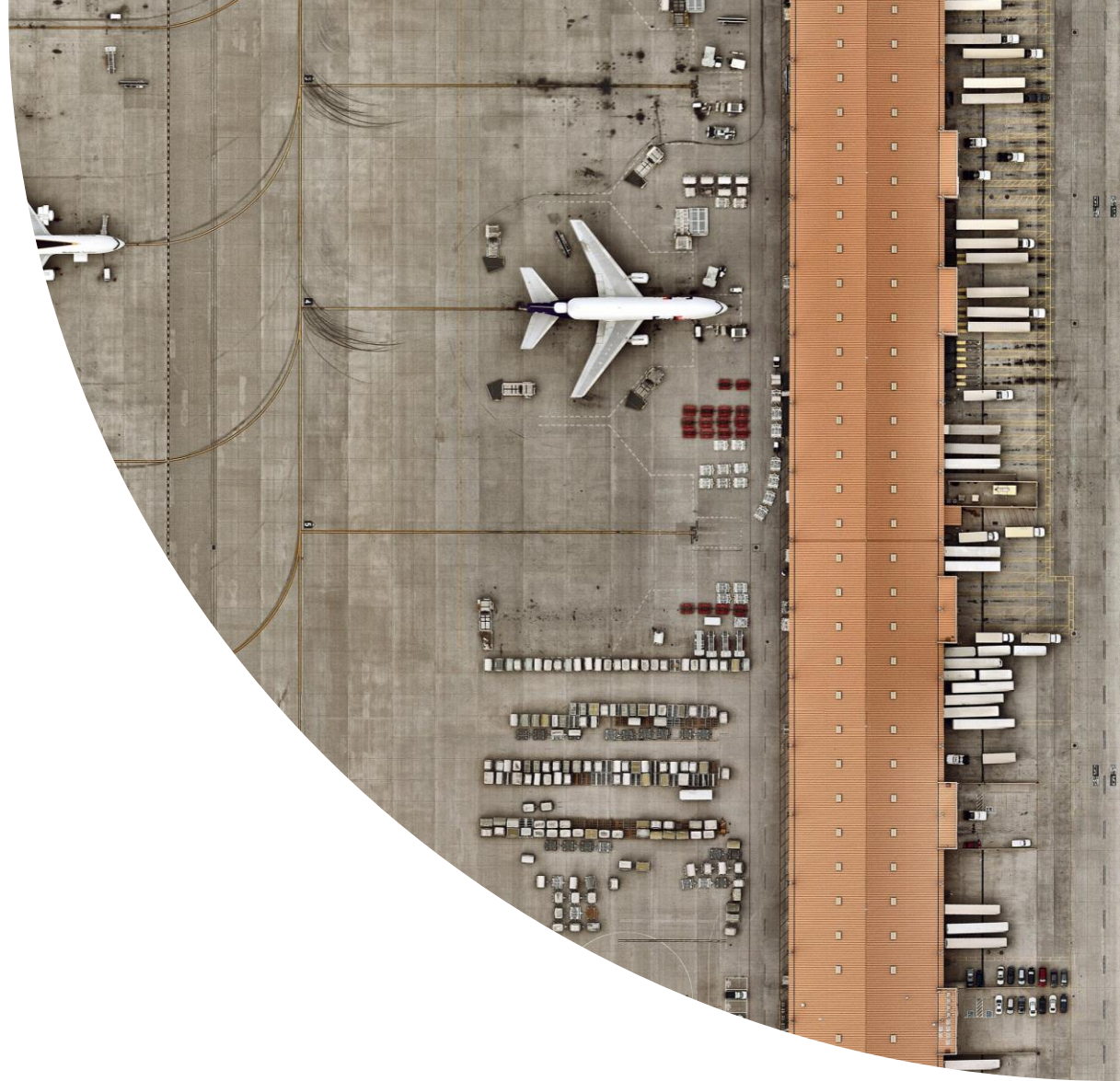
- On the job training (OJT) to upscale their [leading skills](#) in preparation for one auditor audits.

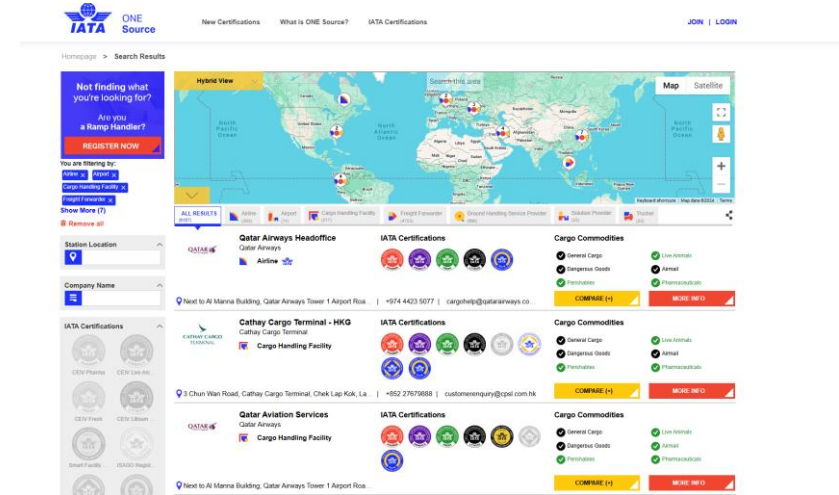

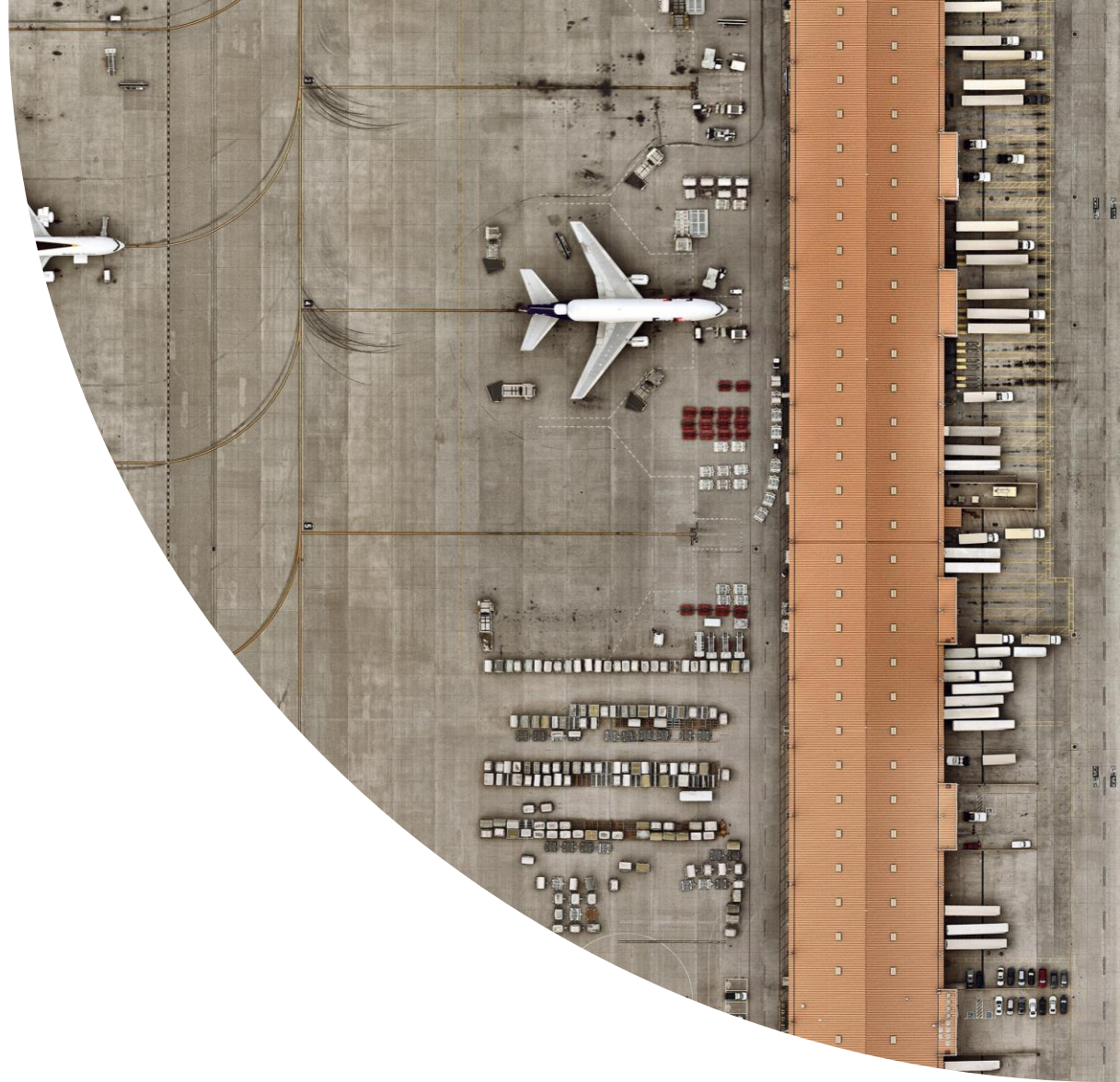

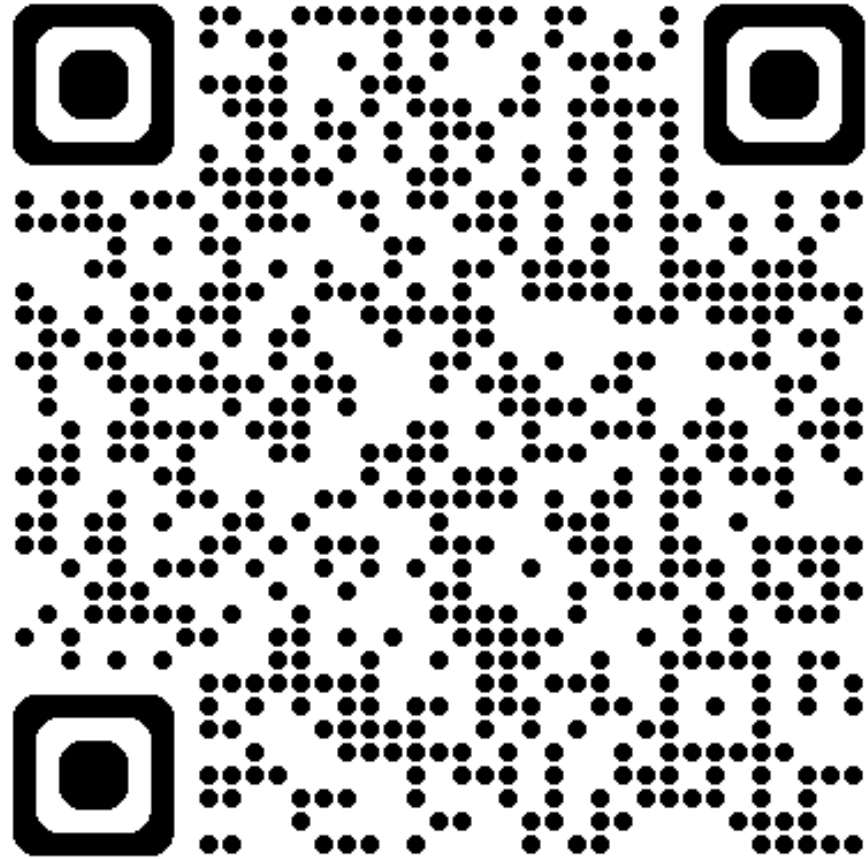

Identified 05 high priority safety risks in ground operations based on IDX/ADX

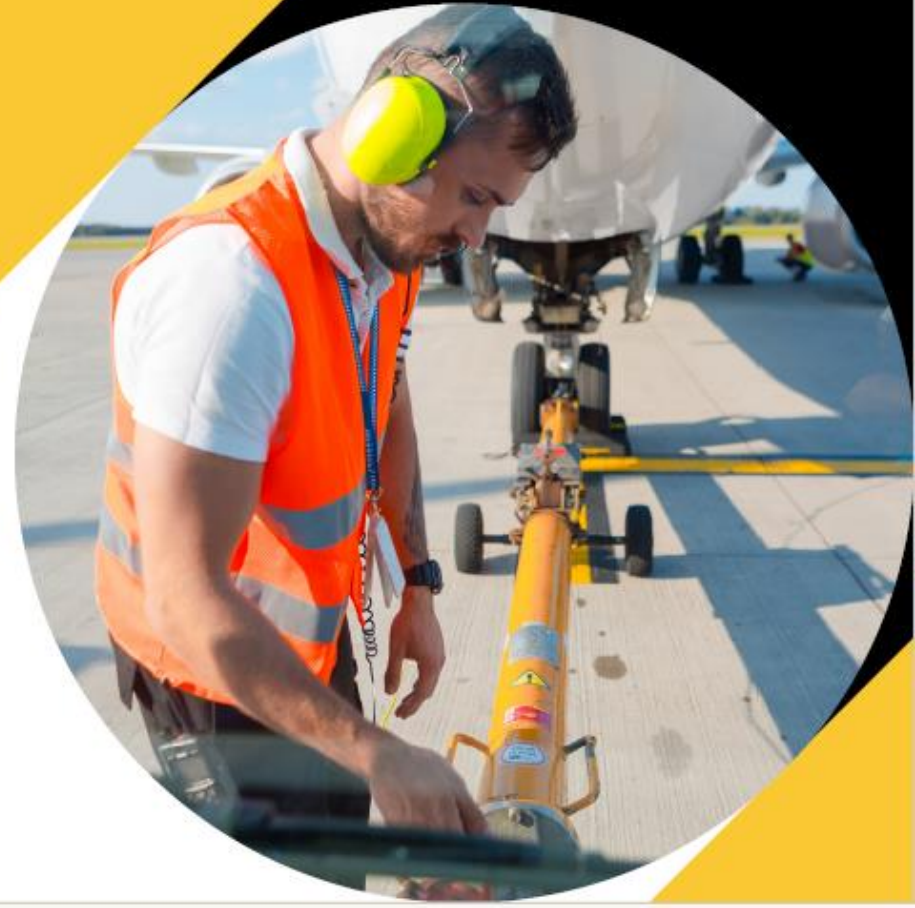
1. Working at height (fall from height)
2. Running Engines
3. Working around running GSE & vehicles in operations
4. Position/Removal of GSE to/from Aircraft
5. Lithium Batteries

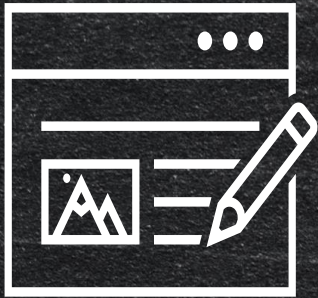

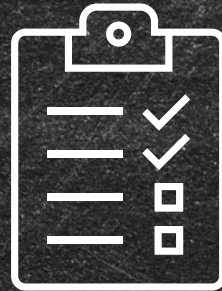

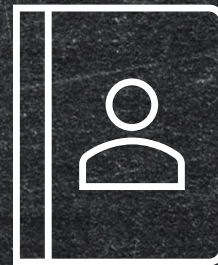
