

Most nationalities can apply for an e-visa while some don't need a visa at all. For all others, tourist visas can be obtained by applying via the nearest Embassy of the Republic of Azerbaijan.

- List of the countries whose citizens are issued single-entry electronic visas at the international Airports of the Republic of Azerbaijan <u>Link visa upon arrival</u>

When applying for e-visas to Azerbaijan, note the following:

- You must apply at least 3 working days before your visit.
- Your passport must be valid for at least 3 months after the e-visa expires.

Getting to the venue by car or taxi

The JW Marriott Baku is approximately 29 kilometers from Heydar Aliyev International Airport.

The journey usually takes around 20 to 30 minutes by car and 40 to 50 minutes using public transport.

Expect to pay around €20 to €30 for a taxi from the airport.

Getting from the airport to the city center by shuttle

Getting from Heydar Aliyev International Airport to the city center by shuttle is convenient, taking about 30 to 40 minutes.



About Baku

Azerbaijan currency

The official currency is the Azerbaijan is the manat (AZN). To change money and get Manats, you can use the currency exchange kiosks available in both Terminal 1 and 2 at Baku international Airport.

There are also ATMs that provide 24 hours customer service including withdrawing cash service at any time available in the airport. Card payments are accepted at most shops and restaurants.

Power outlets

In Azerbaijan, power plugs and sockets (outlets) of type C and F are used. The standard voltage is 220 V at a frequency of 50 Hz.

The weather

In Azerbaijan, May marks the beginning of warmer weather as spring fully arrives. The temperatures in May typically range from 18°C to 25°C across the country. It's generally a pleasant time of year, with blooming flowers and a lot of sunshine. More weather information can be found here.
