



FEES AND CHARGES ARE SIGNIFICANTLY HIGHER IN CANADA: EXAMPLE CANADA VS. USA





ROUNDTRIP EXAMPLE FOR A COMPARABLY DISTANCED DOMESTIC ROUTE IN CANADA AND THE US

The below example compares a roundtrip fare for a comparably distanced domestic route in Canada and the US, with a similar base fare. This example illustrates the impact of high taxes and fees in Canada, which are more than double vs the US in this example.



In short, the high cost of third-party fees and charges represents a significant cost drain for air travel to, from and within Canada, which increases costs, and reduces the ability to invest, thereby impacting the competitiveness of the sector.
