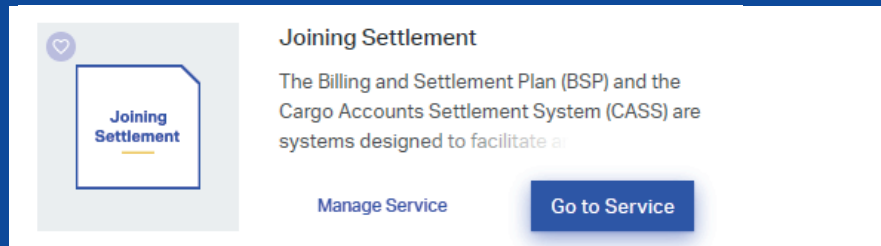


How to join CASS

- 1 Create your account at the → [IATA Customer Portal](#)
- 2 Click **Joining Settlement** under My Service or Available Service, then, select **CASS**



- 3 Select **CASS Export** under Type of Participation, then, complete the Application Form and **submit the required documents** including the Official certificate of company trade registration, the trade License from the economic regulatory department (where applicable), airline banking details.

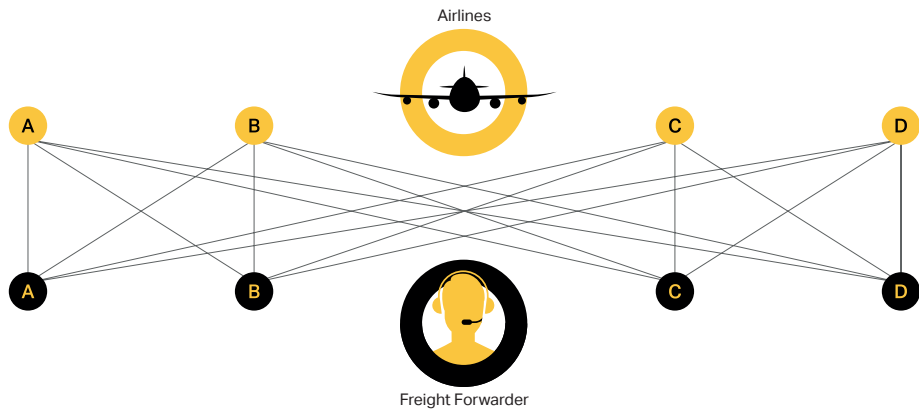

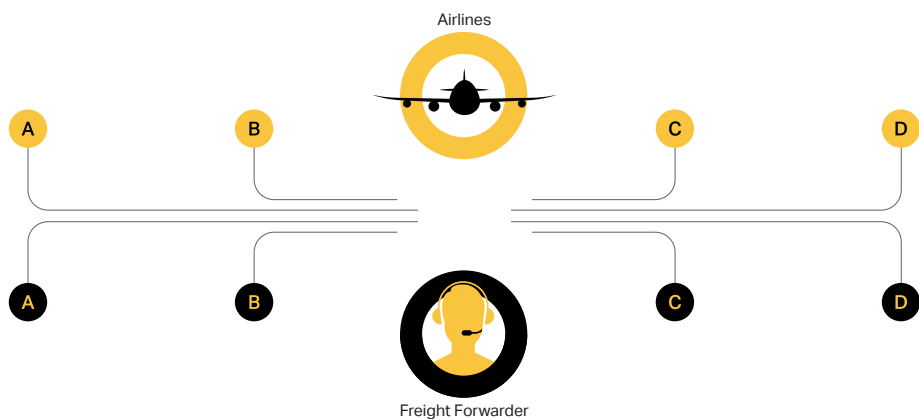

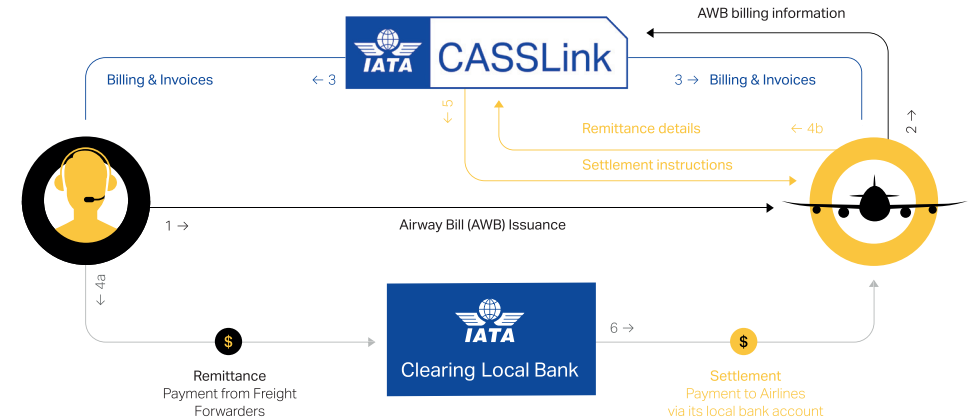

Joining Fee per country	USD 2,500	USD 3,500
Joining Fee per country when 10 countries join at the same time	USD 1,500	USD 2,250
Annual Fee per country	USD 0	USD 500
